

Principles:


- Foresight is early and separate from the political priority setting process

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

Does foresight really change the agenda?

- Political purposes and uses of foresight:
 - To show (token) future awareness:
 - "the future is something we think about"
 - To dispel future ignorance or presumptuousness:
 - "we systematically think about alternative futures"
 - To bring new voices into the policy debate and enable broad and engaging policy deliberations:
 - "we deliberate the future in broad democratic engagement with purpose and responsibility"

- Our experience
 - New habits on how the agenda is formed are bringing in new frames and ideas
 - Organizational hierarchies and routines are slow to change
