














EUROPEAN SINGLE EMERGENCY NUMBER 112

Introduced in 1997

- •Citizens can reach all rescue services at 112:
- -fire-fighters
- -ambulance services
- -other rescue services (i.e. mountain rescuers, cave rescuers, others)
- –police (prime number is 113)
- •24 hours a day, through 13 Regional Notification Centres
- •From landline or mobile phones, free of charge

Volunteers (70%), professional (fire brigades -5%) and civil protection (25%)

- The State (Slovenian Government Administration for Civil Protection and Disaster Relief - ACPDR), Ministry of Defense


RESPONSIBILITIES

Protection Against Natural and Other Disasters

A national safety subsystem aimed at reducing the number of accidents or their consequences.

- West: Sežana (forest fires)

- East: Pekre (IDA)

TRAINING CENTER FOR CIVIL PROTECTION AND DISASTER RELIEF







Training Center for Civil Protection and Disaster Relief of the Republic of Slovenia, located at **Ig** near Ljubljana, established in 1992 as the **main national facility for civil protection training**


