Permit free for 21-90 days

Permit free for 90 days
- Denmark**
Special Individual Qualification required for 90 day permit exemption
- Finland**
Permit free for 90 days with invite or contract
- France**
Permit free for 90 days
- Germany**
Permit free for 90 days
- Hungary**
No permit needed
- Ireland**
Common Travel Area
- Lithuania**
Permit free for 90 days
- Luxembourg**
Permit free for 90 days
- Netherlands**
6 weeks in 13 permit free
- Norway**
Permit free for 14 days
- Poland**
Permit free for 30 days
- Portugal**
Permit free for 90 days

Seeking further clarity

- Cyprus**
Work permit required for stays up to 90 days
- Estonia**
Registration prior to travel-permit free for 90 days
- Greece**
Short term work unclear
- Italy**
Permit free for 90 days but may need justification
- Slovenia**
Schengen visa may be needed
- Latvia**
Permit free for 14 days
- Malta**
Employment license required
- Romania**
Work permit needed
- Slovakia**
Permit free for 30 days but registration
- Sweden**
Permit free for 14 days only with an invitation from approved orgs.
